VIDHYANJALI CARNIVAL

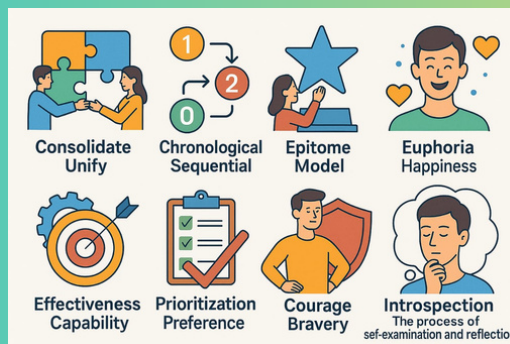
"A CARNIVAL OF COLOURS, CULTURE & CELEBRATION!"

BOOK RECOMMENDATIONS

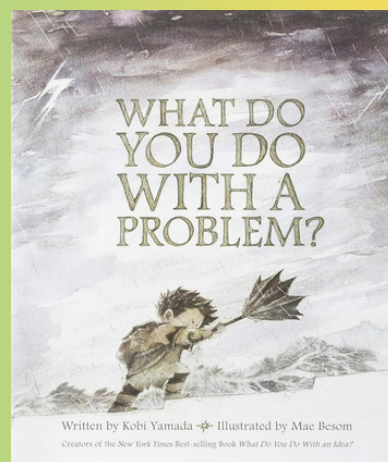
